



Directions to JDA Plantation :

There is water at the site so if you have ducks bring them.

You must bring your own game. If you need game please contact me as soon as you receive this.

If you have access to live game birds, i.e. quail, chukar, pigeons, pheasants or ducks, please call me and let me know what you can bring.

If you're **coming west on I-10** take Exit 192 (US Hwy 90) to Quincy. The site is 12 miles west of the McDonalds located in Quincy and 3.5 miles west of Mount Pleasant, Florida on US Hwy 90. The site entrance is on the right. There are brick entry columns and large pecan trees at the entrance. The small sign on the gate says "JDA Plantation".

If you happen to pass the entry there will be a large water tower on the left.

If you see the large water tower on the left you have passed the entry and if you get to the intersection where Oak grove Church is located on the southeast corner you have gone to far.

If you're **coming east on I-10** take Exit 174 (Hwy 12) east to US Hwy 90. Turn west (left) on US Hwy 90 and proceed to site. Site is on the right, approximately 3.5 miles west of Mount Pleasant.

If you need a map, go to map quest and plug in the City of Quincy, Florida. That's best since there seems to be a number of small towns and areas named Oak Grove. (Imagine that!)
